



Public Lecture - Public Safety and Security in Europe (I)

Commercial Enterprises as Partners with Public Institutions in Fighting Organized Crime and Corruption– Could Europe be a role model to Asia?

Max-Peter Ratzel is a former high ranking German police officer. He has had a 34 year career in national and international police agencies. His last post was Director of Europol, the European Police office, appointed by the Council of Ministers of the Interior of the European Union.

His lecture will consider:

- how to identify organized crime (OC) within a society,
- how to sensitise politicians, citizens and private business to the threat posed by OC and how to develop adequate legislation,
- how to establish a private public partnership to jointly define the threats and future challenges caused by OC,
- how to challenge corruption in all its forms,
 - as individual crime as well as in its characteristic to be an
 - enabling factor to other forms of crime, e.g. OC or terrorism
- how to interlink compliance with public security and safety, based on a holistic approach,
- how to develop and establish a region-wide Organised Crime Threat Assessment (OCTA) in order to inform politicians, professionals and public to be strategically prepared for future OC-threats,
- how to transfer these experiences to other regions of the world in order to counteract global threats.
